## Willenhall Based Will Writer Jim Stanistreet, From BensonWilliams, On Potential Issues Caused by Previous Relationships



A number of years ago I wrote a will for a man who had five children from four different women. The most recent of them (over twenty years his junior) was his current wife and the mother of the youngest child, although they were now separated but not divorced. First things first I wasn't quite sure whether I was supposed to be disgusted or jealous, but his circumstances did open up several issues from a Will writing .perspective.

My first question to him was whether he owned property jointly with his wife (and indeed with any of the previous women) or whether his assets were solely in his own name. Jointly held assets pass automatically to the surviving owner when one dies, so we have to be careful to ensure that assets are "severed" if this is not what a client wants.

Next was the issue of dependency. Statutory law does allow his wife, all three of the previous women, and any of his children, to claim against his estate if they can demonstrate a level of financial dependency which his Will fails to recognise.

No two cases are ever going to be the same on this one, and the success of a claim will come down to the specific circumstances, but our conversation had to be quite detailed to establish levels of dependency and his ongoing financial obligations, if any, to his children and their mothers.

Following on from this we also had to discuss his own personal views on the matter. He was still very close to some of the children, but others had distanced themselves from him. One was estranged altogether, and they had barely seen each other from birth. In the light of this it is perfectly normal that he may wish for some children to inherit more than others, or for some of them not to be mentioned in his Will at all.

Clearly this case was an extreme example, but it is very common these days for people to have been in more than one relationship, and to have children from their previous relationships.

Doing nothing can lead to unwanted claims against your estate and disappointment for those closest to you.

Getting your paperwork in order now will ensure that, whilst adhering to any existing financial obligations you may have, your own wishes are met and your family are protected.



# **Health & Fitness**

#### With Ben Mescam - Personal Trainer and Online Fitness Coach

As Spring moves towards Summer many of us will take steps to try and get healthier. But there are some common mistakes that people make when trying to adopt a healthier lifestyle.

#### **Not Getting Enough Sleep**

Evidence suggests that sleeping fewer hours each night leads to poor health and weight gain. Sustained sleep deprivation triggers changes in our hunger and appetite hormones which can lead to people feeling hungry more often when they're not getting enough sleep.

Sleep helps to reduce stress, improve energy, boost our immune system, reduces inflammation and weight management amongst other things. Long-term sleep loss is linked to dementia, heart disease, diabetes, and obesity. You can also add problems with your immune system, depression and anxiety, and ongoing pain to that list.

Ben's Top Tip: To improve your sleep quantity and quality, make sure you sleep in total darkness while avoiding blue light from mobile phones and devices for a few hours before bed.

#### **Sitting Too Much**

Many of us spend far too much time sitting all day indoors. The advent of homeworking has compounded this further with some people not even needing to leave their front room to start their working day.

If you do commute to work, perhaps you sit on the commute, sit all day at work and then come home to sit down some more before you do it all again. Higher rates of death from heart disease, cancer, and other health-related causes are linked to sitting for more than 6 hours a day.

But most of us could probably improve our health and mood by sitting less and spending an hour or a day outside in the fresh air and just enjoying the nature walking and exploring our local parks and green spaces.

Ben's Top Tips: Try and make a 15 min walk part of your daily morning routine as it will help your body and mind wake up and fire up every cell in the body. Break up your sitting spells with 1-2 minutes of walking every half hour.

#### **Not Drinking Enough Water**



As the average human body is somewhere between 45-75% of water, depending on your age, sex, body composition and fitness levels, it's important that we replace the liquids that we lose every day through breathing, sweating and pretty much every other bodily function. A massive 80% of people aren't drinking enough water with 20% of men and 13% of women not drinking any water at all.

Ben's Top Tips: As 20-30% of our fluids can come from food, so try and incorporate foods like seasonal fruit and vegetables into your diet.

Things like apples, pears and plums are great as well as lettuce, cucumbers and tomatoes and cress. As most of us wake up dehydrated start drinking a large glass of water in the morning as part of your routine.

#### Massively Overestimating Calories Burned During Exercise

Studies find that most people overestimated the number of calories burned in an exercise session by three to four times. This critical mistake led them to consume almost triple the calories they burned during exercise which meant their health did not improve.

While regular exercise has been proven to be even more effective than medicinal treatments for many common health problems, including diabetes, high blood pressure and depression, exercise alone is unlikely to be sufficient in achieving significant long-term health outcomes. So, just because you've spent time in the gym, running or swimming doesn't automatically mean you can treat yourself to whatever you want. For example, a chocolate bar or single slice of pizza can completely erase an hour's worth of physical exertion.

#### **Using 'Healthy Diet' Products**

Stocking up on 'diet'-food products is one of the surest ways to fail in your mission to get healthier and lose weight. Eating 'low fat' food products may seem like a no brainer – but don't be fooled. To compensate for the fat that's removed, other ingredients are usually added to make the food taste like its full-fat counterpart.

These added ingredients don't replace the lost nutrients, however, so you just start craving more food, even though you've just eaten. Even with the best of intentions, you end up eating more than you would have if you'd just eaten the full-fat version in the first place.

Sugar is another culprit in low-fat 'diet' products. Even foods generally considered healthy, such as yoghurt and tomato sauce, are full of extra sugar, resulting in more cravings and usually more consumption.

Ben's Top Tip: Make avoiding diet food products your priority, and focus on eating plenty of vegetables, fruit (fresh or frozen), grains and pulses.

#### **Not Eating Enough**

While drastically cutting calories or skipping meals may seem like a quick fix for getting healthier and losing weight, under-eating can sabotage your efforts to shed those extra pounds.

#### **Cutting Out Entire Food Groups**

Many popular 'fad' diets instruct people to cut out entire food groups, such as fats or carbs. Carbohydrates are often blamed as a cause of weight gain, with "no-carb" diets becoming all too common. While it's true that refined carbohydrates like sugar and white bread and many.



many processed foods can spike blood sugar and lead to weight gain, complex carbs such as wholegrain rice and quinoa, are in fact very healthy.

Another major concern in eliminating entire food groups is the risk of developing nutrient deficiencies, such as a lack of dietary fibre or protein. Unless you have an actual food allergy or intolerance, be wary of embarking on any diet that requires you to ditch important staples of a healthy balanced diet.



# Still having a laugh

He's the celebrity that celebrities avoid, and one of our finest exports.

Many regard Ricky Gervais a national treasure; a select few consider him a national disgrace. Either way, it's hard to avoid the magnitude of the man. In his typical black t-shirt and jeans uniform, the actor, stand-up comedian, writer, producer and director is a melange of passionate sentiment, delivering fixeyed intensity followed by a howling hyena cackle.

A one-time aspiring singer and band manager (he looked after indie outfit, Suede, back in their earliest incarnation), Ricky flitted around the bounds of entertainment with guest spots on Channel 4's The Eleven O'Clock Show before landing pay dirt with self-scripted mockumentary series The Office.

An overnight household name, the gritty comedy launched an unstoppable career.

Follow-up series Extras, parodying the movie industry, was another smash hit, featuring A-list contributions from Kate Winslet, Ben Stiller, Patrick Stewart and Samuel L. Jackson.

It was the perfect introduction into Hollywood, and he went on to star in a series of big budget comedies - Sky Kids, Ghost Town, Night At The Museum, The Invention of Lying and The Muppets. Some topped the box office, others crashed

and burned badly, yet all of them satisfied in Gervais a yearning for originality and creativity, and that flame has never lessened in its



intensity, even in returning to small screen projects such as Life's Too Short, Derek, Special Correspondents and the recent After Life, which garnered rave reviews.

No matter what he takes on – his Netflix project SuperNature last year brought him back to the brilliant stand-up he is renowned for – Gervais, who lives with long-term partner Jane Fallon, is a bastion for freedom of speech and common sense. He has unapologetic honesty that permeates every conversation, whether discussing the "scourge" of religion, or admiring the majesty of the

natural world, or calling out nationalities, races, genders or persuasions, Gervais takes offence at people being offended.

"It's a disease that's getting worse," he says. "It's not healthy and it's not even real. Most of the people who claim to have taken offence by a statement someone makes on Twitter are

actually some of the most offensive people I have ever encountered," he laughs.

As for where 2023 will take this creative powder keg. "As always, I have a few things on the go. I've had time to sit back and raid all those little nuggets of ideas that have been scattered in the back of my mind for too long. Some are pretty good and deserve fleshing out a bit, others are rubbish.

"The challenge is always to keep trying, keep things original, keep the creative processes rolling, and stay ever so slightly controversial!"



# What historic event happened in Willenhall on Saturday 29th September 1923?

The answer is Willenhall Memorial Park was officially opened after years of hard work and planning. The driving forces behind the pioneering scheme were Mr C.H Pinson and Cllr Ambrose Aston, who are remembered in local street names and for the lime tree avenue along the path from Dartmouth Avenue to Noose Lane fields. Ambrose was the original "crowdfunder" of his day.

Work started in 1918 on the pioneering Garden City Scheme undertaken by Willenhall Urban District Council which was designed to commemorate the lives of the soldiers who died in World War One. It was to include housing fit for heroes, a War Memorial, and a park the cost for which was raised by public subscription and cost £10,003 (£650,000 in today's finances).



Returning soldiers were given £1 a week under an unemployment scheme and worked tirelessly with horses and carts, picks and shovels on the derelict Bull Plack Colliery which was described as the worst kind of land covered with pit waste and stagnant water.

Local businessmen R. Carter and J.A. Harper donated a drinking

fountain, a "must have" for local parks in the 1920s. You can still find it in the park today. Many other businesses were generous with "in kind" donations. One donated the shelter which now stands in ruins.

The dream came to fruition and the opening was attended by Mr George Thorne MP. On the centenary of the end of WW1 in 2018 the park became a Fields in Trust site (formerly King George V Playing Fields Association) which protects the land for perpetuity. The inscription on the bandstand reads," Willenhall Memorial Park - Dedicated to those who served and sacrificed- Their legacy surrounds us". Aren't we so fortunate to be able to enjoy such a beautiful park one hundred years on.

The bandstand was added in 1924 with Sunday concerts by Willenhall Brass bands and The Salvation Army who have played regularly ever since. They are playing this summer in the park on Sunday 2nd July.

Sadly, the bandstand became derelict and was demolished in 1954 but replaced in 1997 under a massive restoration programme undertaken between the Friends group and Walsall Council. Other notable assets from the £1 million Heritage Lottery funding are the pavilion, opened in 2005, and the upgraded children's playground with the first innovative Splashpad in Walsall.

The first Carnival was held in 1926 and proceeds were donated to a Willenhall charity. This has become a great local tradition which is still going strong, being held on Saturday 10 June this year. The current Friends group will be at the carnival promoting the 100 years celebration which is on Sunday 16th July. There will be a bandstand concert featuring Cosford Military Wives choir and craft and poetry workshops for children from 2 pm to 4pm which are funded by Creative Black Country.

There will be commemorative brochures from the World War 1 Then and Now project available which outlines the stories of some of the returning soldiers who built the park, and you will have chance to go in the pavilion and see the Peace Tree created by Planet Art which tracks the rich and memorable history of the park.

Hopefully we can capture some of your memories for posterity.



# Willenhall History

In 1287 Richard Leveson of Willenhall was born, to a very elusive family, he went on to marry Margery Clements in 1299. They appear to be wealthy with the males marrying ladies from near and far, usually titled and upon the marriage comes a dowry, thus creating more wealth.

Members of the aristocracy and landowners, men like Sir Walter Leveson 1550-1602 who was an Elizabethan member of parliament and a Shropshire and Staffordshire landowner, he was the son of Sir Richard Leveson who died in 1560.

The Willenhall Levesons built a large mansion house in Tudor style (from 1485) situated between Leveson Street on the north to Wood Street on the south with Stafford Street and Cemetery Road forming the other two boundaries, the house was surrounded by a moat and with the fields known as the Harpers, now part of the Memorial Park (100 years old this year).

In 1666 the Hearth Tax hit the wealthy John Leveson Esq. (of the Moat House) had ten hearths making it the largest house in Willenhall.

A body of trustees in relation to the Capel of Ease Estate (St Giles) regarding an inquiry concerning certain chapel lands held by the Lords of the Manor of Stowheath in 1655, the first man on the list being Sir Walter Leveson, Kt.

Another less known story concerning John Leveson started in about the 660's with Chad, a young man who studied under St Aiden in the monastery of Lindisfarne off the Northumbrian coast. He went on to become the Abbot of Lastingham in Yorkshire and eventually becoming

Bishop of Mercia, unfortunately he died from the plague in 672 and was venerated as a saint. A Shrine was set up for St Chad at Lichfield Cathedral and became a major centre of medieval pilgrimages.

However, in 1538 as a consequence of Henry VIII's Reformation, Prebendary Arthur Dudley smuggled the bones out of the Cathedral. By the time he died in 1577 the relics had been passed to his nieces Bridget and Kathrine Dudley of Russells Hall, Dudley. Then to William and Henry Hodgetts of High Arcal at Woodsetton in Sedgley. William died in 1649, Henry on his deathbed in1651 passed the relics to Jesuit Friar Peter Taylor and after his death in 1665 they moved to John Leveson of Willenhall and were almost destroyed by soldiers during a search.

The relics then went to a seminary at St Omar in France. In the early 19th century, they returned to England and went to Aston Hall near Stone in Staffordshire. The relics eventually ended their journey in 1841 in St Chad's Cathedral Birmingham. (With kind permission from Andrew Homer's "Secret Black Country")

Sir Thomas Leveson the Governor of Dudley Castle in 1642 is believed to be from Willenhall.

John Leveson who died in the mid-18th century was the last male at the Moat House, he left his entire estate to his sister Elizabeth who proceeded to sell land and property including the Bell Inn. By 1800 the Manor House had gone leaving the moat which evanesced when the Wolverhampton and Walsall Railway opened on 1st November 1872 in Temple Bar.
