

It's amazing how good you feel afterwards, even on the odd day when it rained, there was a feeling of achievement. Not just the walking and getting fit, but knowing you've raised a few quid for a good cause.

Pancreatic Cancer is one of the worst types you can get as there are virtually no symptoms until it's too late.

I know a couple of people who have fallen victim to it, so the thought of them got me off my backside every day and I'll do it again next year. Maybe some of you could join me.

There are a few events coming up in the next few weeks and as someone who helps to organise one of them, I know how much hard work goes on in the background, so please, if you are able, please support them and help to keep them going.

Like most people, I was shocked and saddened by the tragic death of the ex-Wolves player Diogo (not Diego!) Jota.

I never met the guy, but his age, the fact that he had only got married to his childhood sweetheart two weeks before the accident and to leave three young children without a father is just heartbreaking.

My father lost his dad in a farming accident when he was just 8 years old. He also had four younger siblings. There was no Universal Credit, oh and there was a war on. I can't imagine how they managed, but they did and Diogo's family will get through this as they have to, as we all have to in tough times.





All nine of our schools who requested have now had visits from the Birds of Prey,
















The Club has also provided the transport for a large party of children and teachers, from

New Season Preview at FC Darlaston



Last season FC Darlaston broke multiple in house records, to cement their highest ever finish in the West Midlands Regional League Premier Division only falling short by 8 points to crowned champions Telford Town who where a formidable outfit throughout. FC Darlaston played 28 games winning 20 drawing 5 and tasting defeat just 3 times leaving a 12 point gap between them and 3rd place - a fantastic achievement for the step7 football club who have clear ambitions to move up through the ranks judging by their recent and ongoing ground development at the ELR Homecare Stadium 69 Hall Street, Darlaston, WS10 8NW, locally known as The Rec.

The Boltmakers success throughout last season didn't go unnoticed by local non-league football enthusiasts which saw more and more new faces showing support week by week. There has been a real surge of interest since the arrival of the clubs current Chairman Michael Greatrex who clearly holds a lot of passion for the football club and the surrounding community it serves.

In the short time since Michael took over, the changes and upgrades locals have seen are a clear indication of his commitment to the cause and it's fantastic to see the venue being so heavily used.

In previous years FC Darlaston have struggled in the division and it seems no coincidence that there 2 best finishes in 23/24 & 24/25 came immediately after the return of current manager Nick Lewis who led the Boltmakers in their promotion winning campaign into the division back in 2018/19.

Michael says, "I'm not going to pretend to know everything about non-league as I only started following since coming to FC Darlaston, but I've definitely got the bug for it now. It's absolutely fantastic and I urge all local football fans to get involved and support where possible. It's very affordable, the excitement before every game is real, the passion is real, the mistakes you may see are human and it all mingles together to make a great afternoon of real football. I've only known Nick a short time but we have quickly formed a great friendship and I've got to say considering him, his staff and the team are all working class lads, the way they conduct themselves when representing FC Darlaston is always in a very professional manner so hats off to everyone of them."

The Boltmakers were unfortunate to be so close but so far away from gaining promotion to Midland Football League Div1 (Step 6) last season and there's a real sense of excitement, expectation and anticipation building at the club for the coming season. Training and pre-season is going well and new faces and signings can be seen around the ground including coaching staff.

The youth that represent the club, look up to the first team and regularly enjoy cheering them on with friends, parents and grandparents alike and there's a real community spirited bond being created here in Darlaston.

Nick Lewis says, "Overall since re-joining the club we have been on quite a high and won the majority of our games but have to feel disappointed at some of the things we have let slip during that time with results in some games, but this has definitely been a learning curve and put us in a better position for the

upcoming season, pre-season has gone well and we have recruited some good

people and players to help us push forward. The club on a whole is a pleasure to be a part of and is only going in one direction it's my job to make sure the first team match that ambition and deliver. We have a great facility and are looked after in all aspects so we would like to reward that by putting some

silverware within our clubhouse. Our chairman and volunteers have been second to none, we would love more volunteers and more supporters to get behind us and the club.



The youth section is now moving in the right direction to give a pathway inside the club and can see the coaches and managers really putting in the hard yards for the players in our younger teams. We cannot wait for the season to kick off and hope to hit the ground running, but we know there will be challenges along the way to get what we want to achieve."

The club has recently achieved 1 star England Football Accreditation and offers lots of activities for sports enthusiasts in the area from coaching sessions to football camps. They have very good relationships with multiple local schools in the area and are constantly looking to find ways of getting children involved to help promote social engagement, active healthier lifestyles, better wellbeing and a sense of belonging such as their recent youth team signing day which saw upwards of 300 people attend the venue.

After a brief chat with one of the youth managers, he explained when Michael first shared his vision for the club at an early committee meeting he wanted to see The Rec being developed and used as it should be for Darlaston's residents and set his sights on a realistic aim of first team football at step 5 (currently step 7).




